I hope to see you on the water and at the meetings.

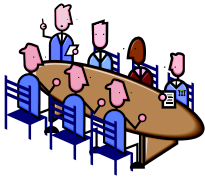

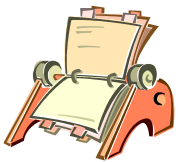
